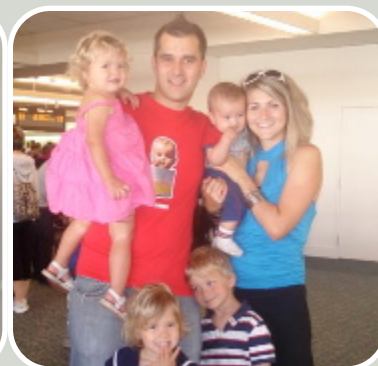


A YEAR OF SEMINARY DONE!

It has brought to the surface weaknesses in our marriage that had previously been unnoticed in light of the chaos, activity, and overwhelming challenges of dealing with other people's problems in Newark. This time has been a refiners fire which is hard, but we are SO thankful for it. The Lord is merciful indeed to discipline His children by exposing and destroying the false idols to which his children so quickly cling. They will not satisfy, and the Lord knows it. The Lord is definitely using this time to prepare us for lifelong ministry, not as much through the books Danny is reading, but by exposing our tendencies to depend on self instead of on Jesus.
